WALK TO MALI LOŠINJ

Mali Lošinj is the largest settlement on the island, it is located at the southern part of the bay Augusta, the largest closed bay of this archipelago. Thanks to this position, Mali Lošinj developed into an important maritime, commercial and today, a touristic center. Mali Lošinj has 6,500 inhabitants and is the largest island town on the Adriatic.

The beginnings of Mali Lošinj go back to the 13th century, when twelve Croatian families came to the island of Lošinj and settled in the eastern bay of "Sv. Martin". The first Croatian settlers were herders and farmers, later switching to fishing, seafaring and shipbuilding.

The golden age of Mali Lošinj was the end of the 19th century when, thanks to seafaring, the small village became a maritime town. Due to the transition from sailing ships to steamships, it seemed that the fate of such and similar towns was sealed. The discovery of the health effects of the island's climate and the emergence of a new economic branch, TOURISM, opened a new page in the history of Mali Lošinj. Today, Mali Lošinj is one of the main tourist centers on the Adriatic, known in all European tourist circles, as evidenced by the many loyal guests who visit us every year.

Lošinj is an island that smells especially nice! The island fragrant garden is a nursery of island medicinal plants in Mali Lošinj. Accompanied by an expert guide, visitors can learn about the rich flora of the island, the healing properties of plants, and buy an original island souvenir.
